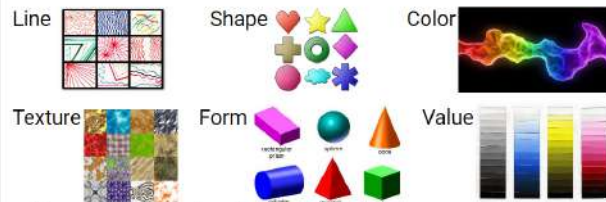
1. Take Home Choice

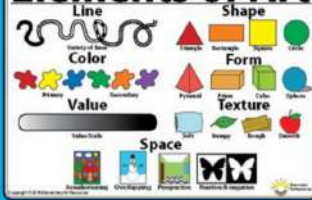


2. Grade Level Choice

Elements of Art



The **Elements of Art** are the “building blocks” of art. The seven basic Elements of Art are used for making art, and understanding/analyzing works of art. The seven Elements of Art are: line, texture, shape, form, color, value, and space.

Lesson Options: Art appreciation lessons designed in question & answer format.

Submit your answers in Schoology.

How to use the online art curriculum....

1. Choose one activity each day that you have Art: You could choose an activity from the *Take Home Choice Board*, the *Grade Level Choice Board*, or you could choose to complete a *Lesson* or a *Lesson Option*.

2. Submit or Share your work:

-**Submit all written work** as discussion or comments in **Schoology**. Written assignments are found in the *Lesson Options*. If a Lesson is labeled “Option #1 & Option #2, then *at least one of those options will be a written assignment*.

-**Share all artworks** in whichever format is easier for you! Options include *Google Docs*, *Google Slides*, *Email*, or *any other format that you are comfortable with*. Share to: lisa.cherivtch@seaford.k12.de.us

3. Why are there so many choices? You are being **offered many** choices due to the **supplies** you may have in your own home, access to **technology**, and **preference of learning style**.
