Last Day of School for 2017-18

Superintendent Travis Fleshner announced that based on action by the Union School Board at their April 9, 2018, meeting, the final day of school for TK-12 students will be Friday, June 1, with an 11 A.M. dismissal. District students will have met the statemandated requirement for instructional hours and will therefore not have to return for the last three school weather make-up days that were scheduled for June 4, 5, and 6.

Lunch Accounts

It is that time of year to check your child's lunch account to see if their balance is in the positive or negative. If you have a positive balance, your money will carry over to next year. If your child will be in the middle school, your account will be carried over there. Only students that are moving will receive money back. All students' lunch accounts need to be paid in full on Friday, June 1. We will have breakfast on the last day of school. On the last week of school, we will have cook's choice for lunch. To help parents out, a total amount of meal prices are listed below: 3 days left for lunch at school 3x2.65(full price) = \$7.95. 4 days left for breakfast at school 4x\$1.60(full price) = \$6.40. So a total of \$14.35 for breakfast and lunch combined.
