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
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# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

### **Mathematics**:

We are beginning our study of **adding** and **subtracting fractions** and fraction problem-solving. Next up is place value to the thousandths place. We will be reading, rounding, comparing, and ordering decimals. Involve your student in cooking and shopping

to encourage working with fractions and decimals!



### Science:

We are beginning the study of **ecosystems** and how everything is connected. We will learn about **producers**, **consumers**, and how **energy** flows in an ecosystem. We will also connect how **living** things depend on **nonliving** things.



### English Language Arts:

In the month of November, ELA students will be reading genres like fairy tales, folk tales, biographies, and even some poetry. Our skills and strategies will have us learning about figurative language, comparing/ contrasting, sequencing, and exploring themes. Fifth graders will also be focusing on plural and possessive nouns in grammar.

### **Social Studies:**


During the month of November, students will be studying the **Earliest Americans**, beginning with **Ancient Americans**. Students will learn how the first people arrived in the Americas, the characteristics of the

We will be learning about the **Design Process** and what it "looks like" to be an engineer.
