# REQUIRED CLASSES

- ◆ 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Mathematics or Accelerated 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Mathematics
  - ◆ 6<sup>th</sup> grade English
  - ◆ 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Science
  - ◆ 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies
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## FULL YEAR ELECTIVE OPTIONS

- ❑ Advanced Computers: Students will use computers, digital cameras, digital video cameras, tri-caster, tripods, & camera booms. Students in this class will help create a video yearbook that will be available for purchase.
- ❑ Band: You can take this class even if you've never played a musical instrument previously
- ❑ Orchestra: You will be given a chance to pick an instrument then you will be paired with a more experienced student if you haven't been part of Orchestra or Band previously.

# 1 SEMESTER OPTIONS

- ◆ Art: Project based learning, students will experiment with 2-D Art
- ◆ CALM: Helps students alleviate & manage stress by teaching strategies to calm themselves such as: Mindful Mediation, yoga & building trust as well as positive peer relationships.
- ◆ Creative Arts & Technology: Students investigate various topics via the internet. You will use Google Classroom to create slideshows.
- ◆ Teen Survival (New Class): This class will focus on 3 things: communication, decision making & goal setting.

# 1 SEMESTER OPTIONS

- ◆ General Music: Students will learn to read music, & to engage in rhythm reading & sight singing. You may be required to participate in a performance at the end of the trimester.
- ◆ Young Authors: Students will explore the genres of personal narratives, essays, fiction, poetry, memoir, research report, grammar concepts. Designed for students with a passion for literacy.
- ◆ Theater: Students will experience performance fun including: creative drama, theater games, role-playing & more.

Physical Education: Basketball, volleyball, floor hockey, track, tennis, softball, badminton, archery, flicker ball, racquetball, & paddleball

# 1 SEMESTER OPTIONS

- ◆ Math Lab: Required if Teacher Recommends it.
- ◆ Writing Lab: Required if Teacher Recommends it.
- ◆ Reading Lab: Required if Teacher Recommends it.

NWEA scores, grades & academic progress are reviewed to determine if a student needs a Lab.


