


Mathematics:

Welcome back! We will continue our investigations of **area**, **volume**, and **combined volume**. We will then begin to calculate **exponents** and **powers of 10**. This year we will be **multiplying using partial products** and the **traditional method**.



Throughout September, we will continue to discover how **landforms**, **natural resources**, and **regional characteristics** of the United States affect how people interact with the land and its resources.
