to you as a parent!

Hornet (Take Home) Folder: The Hornet Folder will be taken home each night and MUST be returned to school the

next day. We will be using these daily. Inside, you will find important announcements, data

and goals we will be tracking, and your child's planner.

Sending Money: It is SUPER helpful if you send money already labeled with: the amount, your child's name,

the teacher's name, and what it is to be used for. Thank you!

Testing: WEEKLY testing includes reading comprehension and spelling. All other <u>big</u> tests will

be scheduled in advance so there is time to study. STATE testing will begin in April

and will include Math, Reading, Writing, and Science.

Accelerated Reading: For my class, your child's goal is to earn 10 AR points each month, but they will also

have a point goal each 9 weeks to earn a special reward from Mrs. Schwarz.

Service Learning Projects: Periodically throughout the year, we will have a special

project and/or volunteering opportunity to help out in the community. I will send out more information as each of
