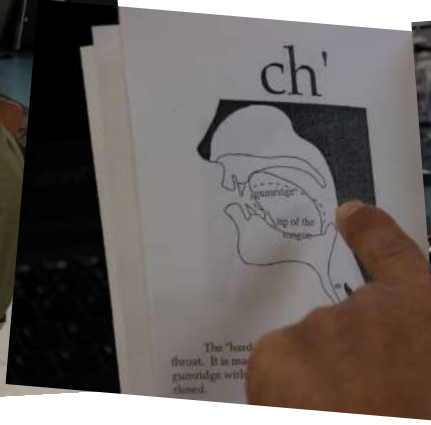
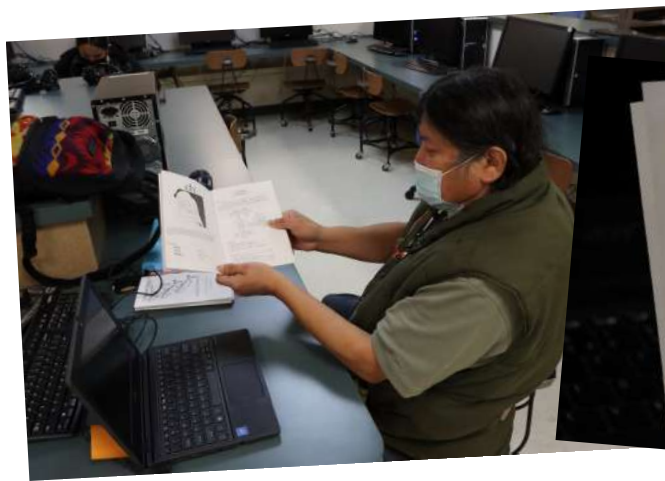


JCMS [Above] - 8th grade AVID students visited COCC in Bend. They were exposed to science opportunities in our area and got a tour of the campus.
