NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

I. PHILOSOPHY

- A. The objective of the MCW Chapter of the National Honor Society is to create an enthusiasm for scholarship, to stimulate a desire to render service, to promote worthy leadership, and to encourage the development of character in pupils of MCW High School.

II. MEMBERSHIP

- A. Membership in this chapter is based upon scholarship, service, leadership, and character. Eligible candidates must have attended MCW High School one semester and have a cumulative 3.33 GPA or better. Members may be chosen during their junior or senior year. All members must uphold the values and attributes for which they are selected.
- B. Members must maintain a cumulative 3.33 grade point average during their junior and senior years to maintain membership.
- C. Failure to uphold NHS attributes may be grounds for removal. Students will be given written notice of problem areas and a reasonable period to remediate the problem.
- D. Violation of MSHSL rules, suspension, expulsion or infractions serious enough as determined by the administration may be grounds for immediate removal.

III. SELECTION

- A. The principal is responsible for supervising the selection process. Eligible candidates will be evaluated by the secondary staff on or about February of their junior and senior year. Successful candidates will be determined by faculty, faculty council, and administration according to the National Honor Society standards and local guidelines. To be considered for selection into the NHS, candidates must complete an essay describing their in-school and out-of-school activities that demonstrate service, leadership and character. This essay will be due the first Friday of third quarter.

IV. SUPERVISION

- A. The activities of this chapter shall be supervised by the principal and advisor.
