Should parents (or students age 18 or older) **NOT** want the following technologies to be used, please schedule an appointment at the District Services Center with the Technology Department. **You must complete an opt-out form, which needs to be completed annually by October 1.**

During the school day, for educational purposes, students have access to:

- The Internet
- Google Workspace for Education Plus and additional district-approved apps
- iPad or school-issued tablet
