Materials Needed:

- Paper
- Markers or colored pencils
- Ink pen

Challenge Instructions:

1. Using markers or colored pencils, draw and color at least 10 random shapes. These shapes should fill your entire paper.
2. Using the shapes as inspiration, draw a face onto each of the shapes. Make the faces as silly or weird as you like! (You can go outside of the original shape if needed to add features.)
3. Make sure to add details to your faces. These could be anything from highlights, skin texture, fur, etc.
4. Have fun!
