2. Minnesota Student Survey (MSS)- Parents in grades 5th, 8th or 11th grade will be receiving communication in regards to the MSS, which will be given to students in these grades in early May. The survey is given every three years and helps track student responses through their time in school. 3. Standardized Testing (MCA's and ACT)- Students in grades 3-11 will begin MCA testing at the end of the month. Students will be testing in our computer labs. Students in grades 3-8 and 10th are testing on English Language Arts, 3-8 and 11th in math, and grades 5, 8, and our biology classes are tested in science. Juniors will take the ACT on April 2nd.
