In addition, the following items will be used by individual students or kept in the homerooms for student use.

- 1 plastic folder for transporting homework and notices back and forth
- 2 pocket folders for specialists
- Small soft sided, zippered pencil case ~ this will be carried throughout the day
- 2 boxes of "good" quality wooden pencils it really does make a difference!
- a pack of pencil top erasers, a few large erasers, 2 colored pens, 1 multipack of multicolored highlighters, 2 black (fine point) Sharpie markers these will go into the pencil case
- 1 ream of colored copy paper if possible
- Crayola colored pencils & classic markers
- In an effort to "Go Green," we are asking that students only use a **reusable water bottle**. Often Poland Spring types of bottles get lost and are wasted because we have to throw them away. Reusable bottles are good for your wallet and our environment! **AND...** <u>PLEASE</u> write the student's name on the bottle as even those can be unclaimed when found.

Some items, such as pens & pencils, will need to be replenished periodically so we recommend that you check in with your child every now and then to see how their supplies are holding up. Often, students come unprepared and therefore cannot actively participate in their learning or complete their work.

In order to keep the students, and teachers, healthy throughout the year we request donations of antibacterial wipes (Clorox, Lysol, etc.) that will be used to clean desks, chairs and lockers and tissues.
