If families are experiencing limitations due to the pandemic this summer and are unable to locate a copy of one of the required books listed below, the texts may be replaced with a choice book.

Then read <u>three</u> books of your choice. You may choose from the list of suggestions below, or choose a different title appropriate for your reading level and personal interests.

- *Ruby Holler* by Sharon Creech
- Chasing Redbird by Sharon Creech
- *Super* by Matthew Cody
- Travel Team by Mike Lupica
- *The Boy on the Porch* by Sharon Creech
- *Touch Blue* by Cynthia Lord

In addition, students will be required to complete the following activities.

Keep a complete list of all the books you read over the summer. Record the author, title, and dates on the list. Rate each title with a 1 – 5 star rating, with 1 being poor and 5 being terrific.
The reading log can be brought to school on the first day, and students should plan to discuss their

summer reading during the first week of school.
