

Attention 6th Grade Parents – Save this information!

The state requires that all students submit proof they have received the immunizations below (or are exempt)

PRIOR to entering 6th grade:

- Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis vaccine (Tdap)
- One dose of meningococcal vaccine (MCV4 or Menactra®).

NOTE - These vaccines are routinely given at the child's 11 year old visit

Incoming 6^h graders should return **proof of immunizations** and all **sports physicals** to the **RMS Health Office** you may:

- email to the nurses directly or
- E-fax to (908) 923-8614
- Drop in RMS lock box

Students who fail to submit immunization documentation may be excluded from school attendance and sports participation.*

*Children who turn 11 <u>after starting 6th grade</u> have 2 weeks from their birthday to submit the required documentation.

Families requiring financial assistance to obtain vaccines should contact the Hunterdon County Childhood Vaccine Program at 908-806-4570.

Now is an excellent time to schedule a well child check-up.

- If your child plans on participating in school athletics at Readington Middle School next year, please have your primary care provider fill out the **Annual Athletic Pre-Participation Physical Examination** forms during their well child check-up.
