Concerts

**Concerts may look a bit different this year with the Covid-19 restrictions. Please note that all performances are subject to change. Depending on the restriction at each given time we may need to alter performances as needed.

Concerts are a major part of your summative assessment grade. All concerts bolded in the schedule below are graded and require attendance. Make sure to mark these performances on your family calendar or post them on the fridge. Concert expectations and grading rubric will be given and explained before each concert.

Excused absences: Excused absences include personal illness, family emergency, and unavoidable family trips (made before the beginning of school year). These absences may be made up by an individual performance of your music for Mrs. Lynch. If an excused absence does occur, an email or phone call must be provided to Mrs. Lynch by a parent/guardian. Make sure to plan ahead in clearing your schedule and arranging transportation.

Unexcused absences: An unexcused absence are absences not verified from a parent or guardian. These absences will be made up with an alternative concert assignment and an individual performance of you part of the concert music.

Concert Dress: Choir members should wear <u>appropriate dress clothes</u> for performances. It's important to look our best! All outfits must follow the HHS dress code. <u>Girls</u>- dress pants/skirt/dress, dress shirt and dress shoes (no high heels) <u>Boys</u>- Dress pants, dress shirts and dress shoes.

Music Awards All 6th grade choir members are eligible for the following awards.

Singer of the Year: Given to one student that has demonstrated outstanding vocal skills, leadership, and attitude.

Most Valuable Vocalist: Awarded to the student that has demonstrated outstanding vocal skills.

Most Improved: awarded to the students that has improved the most vocally and musically through the year.

Unsung Hero Award: Awarded to the student that has demonstrated outstanding leadership, attitude, hard work and dedication.
