### **Concerts**

Please note that all performances are subject to change. Depending on the restriction at each given time we may need to alter performances as needed.

Concerts are a major part of your summative assessment grade. All concerts bolded in the schedule below are graded and require attendance. Make sure to mark these performances on your family calendar or post them on the fridge. Concert expectations and grading rubric will be given and explained before each concert.

**Excused absences**: Excused absences include personal illness, family emergency, and unavoidable family trips (made before the beginning of school year). These absences may be made up by an individual performance of your music for Mrs. Lynch. If an excused absence does occur, an email or phone call must be provided to Mrs. Lynch by a parent/guardian. **Unsung Hero Award:** Awarded to the student that has demonstrated outstanding leadership, attitude, hard work and dedication.
