ELA	<p>In the 2024 - 2025 School Year, we rolled out a new English Language Arts curriculum in grades 6, 7, and 8 called Fishtank ELA. Math	<p>In grades K-8, we use the <i>Illustrative Mathematics</i> (IM) curriculum. IM Math is a problem-based core curriculum rooted in content and practice standards to foster learning and achievement for all. Students learn by doing math, solving problems in mathematical and real-world contexts, and constructing arguments using precise language. Information for families is available online in both English and Spanish.</p>
Science	<p>In 6th grade science, we use a curriculum called STEMScopes, which is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards and the MA Curriculum Frameworks.</p>
Social Studies	<p>In 6th grade social studies, 2024-2025 is a transition year from our district-created units to using the Investigating History curriculum.</p> <p>Here's a google site with the units broken down which can be a helpful to understand the content covered in each unit:</p> <p>https://sites.google.com/view/investigating-history/grade-6</p>
