Math	In grades K-8, we use the <i>Illustrative Mathematics</i> (IM) curriculum. IM Math is a problem-based core curriculum rooted in content and practice standards to foster learning and achievement for all. Students learn by doing math, solving problems in mathematical and real-world contexts, and constructing arguments using precise language. Information for families is available online in both English and Spanish.	
Science	In 6 th grade science, we use a curriculum called <u>STEMScopes</u> , which is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards and the MA Curriculum Frameworks.	
Social Studies	In 6 th grade social studies, 2024-2025 is a transition year from our district-created units to using the Investigating History curriculum.
