Course Descriptions

Beginning Band*: Learn how to play one of the following instruments: flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, cornet, trombone, baritone horn and tuba. Band performs at two HDMS concerts.

Beginning Choir: Learn fundamental musicianship for singing, sight-reading music and playing accompanying instruments through a wide variety of music. The beginning choir performs at two HDMS concerts.

Beginning Orchestra*: Learn to play a string instrument! Choose between violin, viola, cello and bass. Orchestra performs at two HDMS concerts.

Foods: This class introduces 6th graders to nutrition and cooking. Learning how to read recipes, measure, cooking skills, kitchen safety, teamwork skills, nutrition, table setting and manners are included in the course. Students also learn how to set a budget and follow it while meal planning. Please be aware that students with food allergies will possibly come in contact with foods they are to avoid.

Introduction to Technology: This course introduces students to the ever-advancing world of technology and technology related opportunities. Students will practice keyboarding, data management and software/hardware troubleshooting. In addition, students will be prepared for future electives by practicing problem solving techniques related to engineering principles and scientific inquiry.

Psychology of Success:

This class will give students a range strategies, skills and support to help them find success academically, socially and emotionally, as they transition to middle school. Topics include organization, communication, bullying, and healthy relationships.

* As a general rule you will need to provide your own instrument. The school does have a limited number of instruments that can be borrowed for a \$40 usage fee.
