What is 6th Grade Girl's IM Basketball?

Intramural basketball is an eight-week program designed for 6th Grade Berkshire Middle School girls interested in playing basketball, regardless of playing experience. The purpose of this program is to have **fun**, while learning and improving on the fundamentals and skills of basketball.

When and Where are the practices and games?

Intramural basketball runs from September-October. Practices will be held on Mondays (7-8 a.m.), Wednesdays (7-8 a.m.) and Fridays (7-8 a.m. or 3-4:30 p.m.) at Berkshire. A schedule will be given out on the first day of practice.

*This is an intramural program and all games will be against other 6th grade girls from Berkshire. No games will be played against other schools.

The first practice will be on Wednesday, September 11th at 7:00 a.m. The locker room will be opened at 6:55 a.m. Proper attire should be worn. (gym shorts, t-shirt, and gym shoes)

**Players should enter the school from the South parking lot through the doors closest to the football/soccer field. These doors will be unlocked at 6:55 a.m. and locked at 7:10 a.m. If a player arrives after 7:10 a.m., they must wait by the main entrance of the school until those doors open at 7:30 a.m.*
