Required Health Office Documents

YEARLY PHYSICAL

- 6th Grade Students are required to have a yearly physical prior to starting the school year.
- Due Date: 9/23/2022
- Click on link to be directed to the [Universal Health Physical Form](#)

Note: If your child is not due for his/her annual physical, please supply the Health Office with a note including the date and time of his/her appointment no later than 9/23/2022

IMMUNIZATIONS

- [TDap-](#) 1 dose required for all entering sixth graders who are 11 years of age or older
- [Meningococcal-](#) 1 dose required for all entering 6th graders who are 11 years of age or older

Note: Immunization records are required to be submitted to the Health Office no later than 9/23/2022.

If your child is not due for immunizations, please supply the Health Office with a note including the date and time of his/her appointment

**** The Burlington County Department of Health immunization audit will take place October 2022. Failure to provide documentation will result in student exemption****

Required Health Office Documents Continued

Consent for Health Services/Yearly Health Update Form

- Medford Lakes requires the Yearly Health and Health Services Consent Form to be completed no later than 9/23/2022

Consent for Over The Counter Medications

- Medford Lakes School District requires the OTC consent form to be completed and returned to school
- All OTC medications of been approved by the Medford Lakes School District Physician

Approved Medications:

Acetaminophen (Tylenol)
Ibuprofen (Motrin)
Diphenhydramine (Benadryl)
Throat Lozengers/Cough Drops
Antacid Tablets (Tums)

Medication Forms

Medication Administration

New Jersey State law PROHIBITS administration of ANY medication, including "over - the- counter" medication without a DOCTOR'S ORDER.

- All medications MUST be in its original container with the student's name and valid expiration date
- Medications must be handed to the school nurse by a parent/guardian

****STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CARRY THEIR OWN MEDICATION INCLUDING OTC****

Asthma Action Plan

- If your child has Asthma and needs and inhaler or nebulized treatments during the school day, a physician **MUST** complete an [Asthma Action Plan](#)
- With physician authorization only, students may be permitted to self carry their inhaler

****NOTE: A new Asthma Action Plan needs to be completed for every school year****

Allergy Action Plan

- If your child has a life threatening allergy and requires an EpiPen, a physician **MUST** complete and [Allergy Action Plan](#).
- In the case that the school nurse is not immediately available, parents can opt to have a trained delegate to administer an EpiPen to your child by completing the [Delegate Form](#).
- With physician authorization only, students may be permitted to self carry their EpiPen

****NOTE: A new Allergy Action Plan needs to be completed for every school year****

Required Health Camp Forms

1. **Yearly Health Services/Yearly Health Update Form** - if not turned in already
2. **OTC Medication Permission Form** - if not turned in already
3. **Confidential Health Information Form** - this form indicates if your child has any specific dietary needs/restrictions, phobias, mental/social/emotional health concerns etc

Medications

ALL medication must be supplied to the the Health Office in the original bottle by a parent/guardians

Medication must have a valid expiration date

Medication and appropriate administration forms must be supplied to the nurses office no later than 7 days prior to the trip.

6th Grade Medical Form Checklist

Yearly Health Update/Permission for Health Services Form

☐ Due by 9/23/2022

This form provides the Health Office an updated medical history for your child as well as consent for treatment for health related service

Updated Immunization Record/Or Appointment Card

☐ Due by 9/23/22

An updated immunization record with 11 year old vaccinations (Tdap/Meningococcal) **MUST** be provided to the nurses office. Failure to do so will result in exclusion.

Medication Administration Form

☐ Due 2022/2023 School Year

This form **MUST** be completed by a physician prior to any medication being administered at school or camp.

IE: ADHD medications, Allergy medications, Supplements, Seizure medications

Consent for Over the Counter Medications

☐ Due by 9/23/2022

Allows consent for the Medford Lakes School District approved OTC medications to be given by Health Office personnel

Confidential Health Information Form (Camp Ockanickon)

☐ Due Date: TBD

This form assists in providing emergency contact information and to identify any medical, social, emotional, and physical needs to ensure a great camp experience

Asthma Action Plan/Allergy Action Plan

☐ Due 2022/2023 School Year

These forms are required to be completed by a physician if your child has Asthma or an Allergy that requires the use of medication
