






6th grade Snow Day Menu

English 	<p>Reading Plus (for students with internet access) or read a book for at least 20 minutes</p> <p>Write 10 complete sentences on how you spent your day!</p> <p>* Be sure to check for capitalization, punctuation, and correct spelling.</p> <p>* Use a variety of subjects and predicates in your sentences.</p>																		
US History 	<p>Use your laminated map that is located in your folder to label the continents and oceans as well as the states on the back. Complete this activity 5x. You will use the handout labeling the states or use the internet to assist you. Do not erase the map after you do this the last time. Please leave your answers on your map for your teacher to see.</p>																		
Math 	<p>Students with internet access- You will go into multiplication.com and do at least 40 minutes of practice. We can track your time, so make sure to complete 40 minutes.</p> <p>Students without internet access-You will make your own multiplication chart. Your chart needs to go from 0-12. So basically, you would have 144 answers on your perfect square chart.</p>

Venture outside if possible or look out the window and describe the weather conditions present to include: cloud cover (cloudy, partly cloudy, or clear) and precipitation (rain, sleet, snow, hail, or none). Electives
