
6th Grade Summer Math Packet

The first section is a review of the 4 math operations. The second section is a card trick to track your thinking and reasoning.

4 Operation Review:



You will need a deck of cards for this trick!



- Your goal is to set up your deck of 13 cards so that they come out in the
 order: A, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, J, Q, K. Here's the tricky part: you aren't
 turning over the cards in order. Follow this guide and then figure out the
 trick!
- Guide for doing the trick:
 - o Reveal the top card (it should be an Ace) and place it to the side
 - o Take the next card in the deck and move it to the bottom
 - o Reveal the new top card (it should be a 2) and place it to the side
 - o Take the next card in the deck and move it to the bottom
 - o Reveal the new top card (it should be a 3) and place it to the side
 - o Take the next card in the deck and move it to the bottom
 - o Repeat until you can reveal A, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, J, Q, and K in order!
