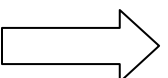

Even though school is ending for summer break, that doesn't mean reading needs to end as well! Extensive research shows that children who continue to read during the summer maintain or improve their reading skills and perform better when school resumes. To promote summer reading, we are expecting that all incoming Chardon Middle School 6<sup>th</sup> Graders read and complete one line on the BINGO chart.

### DIRECTIONS:

- € Students should choose books at their interest and reading level.
- € Students need to complete at least 1 BINGO line (across, up-and-down, or diagonal)
- € Students **MUST** have a parent/guardian signature in **EACH box completed** along with the book/author information required.
- € Students may complete more than one BINGO line, but only one line is required
- € *Free Space* counts as a completed book and doesn't need a signature
- € HAVE FUN!
- € Students will receive a raffle ticket for each bingo line completed.
- € GRADING:
  - Students will receive points for completed boxes in one BINGO line (MUST have parent/guardian signature) (15 points)
  - Students will have an in-class writing assignment related to their BINGO chart (15 points)

Independent self-selected reading is an integral part of the 6<sup>th</sup> grade language arts curriculum. We will do our best to help students fall in love with books and see themselves as readers and grow strong as readers and writers.
