

6th Grade Summer Math Log

For Students Taking Math 7 in 6th Grade

Parents and Guardians,

We are asking that all students entering the sixth grade during the 2024-2025 school year complete a summer math log. Students are required to log a minimum of 10 hours of math and are encouraged to complete the 6th grade IXL topics.

We understand this will require time and effort, however, it is extremely beneficial to keep our math skills sharp over the summer as we move at a rapid pace in 6th grade mathematics. Students may work on any activities listed below.

- Students are required to complete 10 hours of math over summer break
 - This equates to about 1 hour a week
- Students choose from the following categories and keep a log
 - IXL
 - Work towards meeting 6th grade goals of 80% or higher on all topics.
 - Khan Academy or a different academic website
 - “Cool Math” does **NOT** count
 - Any work with a summer math tutor
