Concordia Jr./Sr. High School is pleased to offer a summer session. Here is some information that will hopefully be helpful.

- ☀ Summer School at CHS is for students who will be in seventh grade through the twelfth grade this fall.
- ☀ Students should enroll in the grade they will be in this fall.
- ☀ Summer School at CHS will be held Monday through Friday beginning **Monday, June 4 and continuing through Friday, June 22**. ITV, Dual Credit and Online courses will follow their own schedule and have specific requirements for enrollment. There are costs and attendance requirements associated with ITV, Dual Credit and Online courses.
- ☀ The school day will begin at 8:00 am and end at Noon or 12:05, depending on the class.
- ☀ Limited transportation will be provided with bus stops in Aullville, Ernestville, Emma, Metro East, on Orange Street and St. Louis Street. Specific transportation information will be sent home after enrollment.
- ☀ We will also make a stop at the Community Center after school Mondays through Thursdays for students who have lunch at the Food For Kids Program (If available). Parents will have to make arrangements to get home from there.
- ☀ There will be no breakfast or lunch service provided during Summer School at CHS.
- ☀ All you need to do to enroll your student is fill out the Enrollment Form. The form will also be available on our website at www.concordia.k12.mo.us.
- ☀ Enrollment forms should be returned to the school office by **Friday, May 4, 2018**.

A+ Tutoring: 8:00 am-10:00 am and 10:00 am-12:00 pm--June 4-22

Students needing A+ tutoring hours may tutor at CES during the summer session. Two to four hours of tutoring is available each day. (30 to 60 hours for the entire session). All tutoring opportunities will take place at CES. Space is limited so sign up soon. This summer there will be a limited number of spots for A+ tutors due the amount of classes and small class sizes.

- **approval of your principal**
- **must have completed the sophomore year**
- **some classes require the ACT test**
