THE 7 ELEMENTS OF ART

LINE: ELEMENT OF ART THAT IS A CONTINUOUS MARK. THERE ARE FIVE KINDS.

Vertical: Lines that are straight up and down

Horizontal: Lines parallel to the horizon

Diagonal: Lines that slant

Curved: Lines that are always bending and turning **Zigzag**: Lines that are formed by short, sharp turns

SPACE: ELEMENT OF ART REFERRING TO THE AREA'S; AROUND, ABOVE, OR BELOW. THERE ARE TWO KINDS:

Positive: Space the object takes up **Negative:** Space around the object

TEXTURE: ELEMENT OF ART THAT REFERS TO HOW THINGS FEEL OR APPEAR TO FEEL. THERE ARE TWO KINDS:

Actual: You can feel You can see

VALUE: ELEMENT OF ART THAT DEALS WITH THE RELATIVE DEGREE OF LIGHTNESS AND DARKNESS

It is also one of the three properties of color

FORM: ELEMENT OF ART THAT IS THREE- DIMENSIONAL AND ENCLOSES SPACE. IT HAS LENGTH, WIDTH, AND HEIGHT. THERE ARE TWO KINDS:

Organic: Free flowing, in nature and

SHAPE: ELEMENT OF ART THAT IS TWO-DIMENSIONAL AND ENCLOSES SPACE. IT HAS LENGTH AND HEIGHT. THERE ARE TWO KINDS:

Organic: Free flowing, in nature

Geometric: Mathematical

COLOR: ELEMENTS OF ART DERIVED FROM THE REFLECTED LIGHT. THERE ARE THREE PROPERTIES:

Hue: Name given to a color Intensity: Brightness to dullness Value: Lightness to darkness
