The party will take place the same day (May 30th), right after school from 3:00 to 5:00 at GMS.

In Morning Meeting, teachers will present each of their students a graduation certificate and view slides that each student made to commemorate their time at GMS. Morning Meeting classes will also watch a video with pictures of all the students during their time at GMS. The video will be shared online if you are interested in watching. The party will take place right after school and is a great opportunity for parents to be involved by volunteering for a wide range of fun activities!

3:00 - 5:00 - The Party! There will be many events including, Karaoke, Pop/Candy Walk, Fun Time Photos, Prize Drawings, DJ Music, Outdoor Inflatables, Dodgeball, Hawk Stop, snacks and drinks! All photos will be uploaded to Shutterfly for parents to download.

5:00 - Parents will pick up their students at GMS. Bus transportation is also available for those who signed up.
