#### **Mathematics:**

Students in seventh grade will be learning about statistics and will learn how to solve real world problems.

Seventh graders will also be learning about mathematical concepts including Algebraic expressions, inequalities,

Geometric figures, and ratios and proportions to learn how to solve real world problems and scenarios.



#### **Social Studies:**
