

Observational Shoe Contour Drawing with Patterns



Background Color Optional

Step 1: On a blank piece of paper with a pencil, draw an observational drawing of a shoe. Use the shoe right off your foot or a more interesting shoe close by if you wish. Fill up the space of your paper by drawing your shoe BIG in the center. You are only drawing the outlines of the shoe, do not color in. Get all the details!

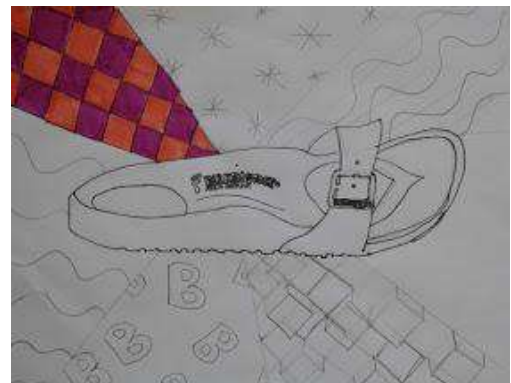


Step 2: Break up the background into large sections. Add a different pattern in each section of your background, remember NEATNESS and CRAFTSMANSHIP!



Step 3: OPTIONAL Color in the background with markers or colored pencils using a pattern in each section. Leave the shoe black and white.
