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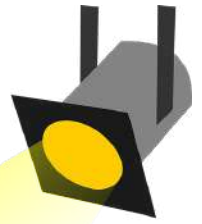

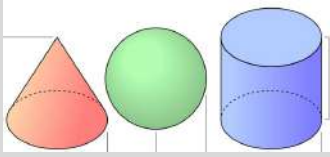
SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT:



Mathematics:

Pre-Algebra: We will be studying congruence and similarity. We will also be working with formulas.

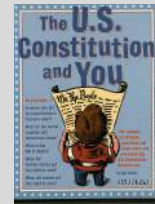
Algebra: We will be learning exponents and roots and starting statistics. We are getting ready to prepare for Keystones!



Social Studies:

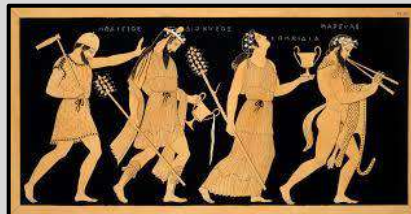
During the month of April, students will be learning about and analyzing the events of the Revolutionary War and the drafting of the United States Constitution.

English Language Arts:

Science:
