Grading

Every assignment is worth 10 points.

You are graded on effort and behavior.

Points are deducted for the following reasons:

Being late to class.

Behavior issues.

Wasting time.

Missing or incomplete work

Distracted during instructions.

Quizzes may be given if you are not listening to instructions.

1 point is deducted for every tardy.

Any daily work not made up is worth 0 points.
