SUBJECT SPOTLIGHT:




Mathematics:

Students in Pre-Algebra will be discussing linear equations and functions. We will use equations to solve problems in the real world.

Students in Algebra are working to solve variations of linear equations as well as

solve systems of equations (multiple equations that
