Program

- Associate Degree in General Studies by the end of students' senior year in high school
- Tuition FREE college coursework
- Must have completed Spanish III and Trig by the end of the 10th grade year
- Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher

Sports

- Student-Athletes must:
 - Have a VHSL physical dated after May 1st of each year
 - Maintain grades
- Activity buses run after school at 6:00 to transport student-athletes to drop-off points and selected elementary schools throughout the county after practices
- Athletic physicals are typically offered by the school system in Mid-May immediately after school in the PCHS Gym, cost is \$10.

Important Point!

- Put time and effort into your class work!
- Grades high school credited classes WILL go on your transcripts ad count towards your cumulative GPA and WILL be seen by colleges!
- Attendance block schedule covers large amounts of instruction each day, a day missed can put you behind very quickly!

Remember

- Students will complete the worksheet and use it as a guide to register for upcoming 8th grade classes online thru the PowerSchool portal
- Math and English placement will be determined by grades, SOL scores and teacher recommendations.
- Think about the future when selecting classes!
