# Important Terminology

- 1 Semester long “passed” class = 1 credit
- 7 periods per day X 2 semesters = 14 possible credits per school year
- Freshman Seminar = full year, every other day course focusing on “My Place - My Path - My Future”; develop skills to help navigate a successful HS career; *required for graduation*
- Program of Study = a three course sequence in a chosen Academy; *required for graduation*



# Terminology cont.

- **Accelerated = placed according to test scores (placement made for you)**
- **AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)**
