••• Important Terminology

- > 1 Semester long "passed" class = 1 credit
- > 7 periods per day X 2 semesters = 14 possible credits per school year
- Freshman Seminar = full year, every other day course focusing on "My Place - My Path - My Future"; develop skills to help navigate a successful HS career; required for graduation
- Program of Study = a three course sequence in a chosen Academy; required for graduation

••• Terminology cont.

- Accelerated = placed according to test scores (placement made for you)
- AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)
