EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to passing the required courses listed above, New York State has established examination requirements. To receive a high school diploma, a student must achieve a passing score in English, Mathematics, Global History, U.S. History & Government, and Science.

- 1. For the Regents Diploma, a student must achieve a minimum score of a **65 on the following Regents Examinations:** English, Algebra I, Global History & Geography, U.S. History & Government, and a Science.
- 2. For the Advanced Regents Diploma, in addition to the above, a student must achieve a **minimum score of 65** in Geometry, Algebra 2, Living Environment and the locally created World Language Check Point "B" exam.
- 3. *Local Diploma option is only available to classified students with disabilities
