

Laude & Indexing System

The purpose of the Laude System is to reward graduating students who perform at a high academic level and choose highly academic courses.

- · Students must have an Indexed Cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher to be considered.
- · .025 is added to the student's GPA for each .5 credit course completed
- · Students earn one laude point for each .5 credit Indexed Class completed.
- · Courses with a designations of AP, Honors, CAPP and CLEP all earn 1 laude point for every .5 credit earned.
- · Students are responsible for knowing their own laude status. (Cum laude=14, Magna Cum Laude=20 & Summa Cum Laude=28)

Opportunities for earning College Credit



<u>CAPP (6)</u> ~ CAPP stands for Cooperative Academic Partnership Program. Our teachers are certified to teach a particular college's curriculum so our student can earn college credit from UW Oshkosh. These credits may be transferred to other colleges by sending a transcript from UW Oshkosh to your destination college. This is the same for our Honors PreCalc UWGB Math 104 ~ Transcript has to be sent from UW Green Bay to your destination college to request credit to be transferred.

<u>CLEP (2)</u> ~ CLEP stands for the College Level Examination Program. **CLEP** exams help students earn college credit for what they already know, for a fraction of the cost of a college course.

AP (19) ~ AP stands for Advanced Placement. Students complete our curriculum, take the AP Exam in the spring and if they earn a 3 or higher on the exam, can earn college credit. The cost of the AP Exam for this year was \$102.

<u>Transcripted Credit (14)</u> ~ Transcripted Credit is also known as dual enrollment courses. A student in high school signs up for a course that has an agreement with a post-secondary institution and if they meet the requirements of the course, the student receives high school and college credit...for free!

- → Current Freshmen must register for 8 credits for Sophomore Year.







- When choosing courses, you only need to enter in classes for next school year. You can plan courses for future years, but those classes will not be scheduled at this time.
- The Grade Level highlighted in Grey is the year the student is scheduling for.

- If a blue alert pops up, there is a note to read regarding the course. Typically, this relates to a course fee. You are still able to register for this course.
- If a red alert pops up, there is a prerequisite issue. You need to remove that course from your plan and add another selection in order to submit your requests.
