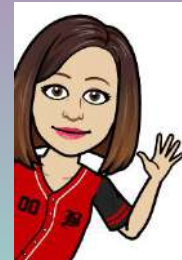

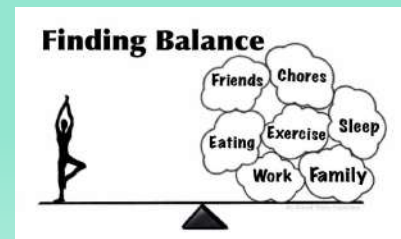

Laude & Indexing System

The purpose of the Laude System is to reward graduating students who perform at a high academic level and choose highly academic courses.

- Students must have an Indexed Cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher to be considered.
- .025 is added to the student's GPA for each .5 credit course completed
- Students earn one laude point for each .5 credit Indexed Class completed.
- Courses with a designations of AP, Honors, CAPP and CLEP all earn 1 laude point for every .5 credit earned.
- Students are responsible for knowing their own laude status. (Cum laude=14, Magna Cum Laude=20 & Summa Cum Laude=28)

Opportunities for earning College Credit



CAPP (8) ~ CAPP stands for Cooperative Academic Partnership Program. Our teachers are certified to teach a particular college's curriculum so our student can earn college credit from UW Oshkosh. These credits may be transferred to other colleges by sending a transcript from UW Oshkosh to your destination college. This is the same for our Honors PreCalc UWGB Math 104 ~ Transcript has to be sent from UW Green Bay to your destination college to request credit to be transferred.

CLEP (1) ~ CLEP stands for the College Level Examination Program. **CLEP** exams help students earn college credit for what they already know, for a fraction of the cost of a college course.

AP (19) ~ AP stands for Advanced Placement. Students complete our curriculum, take the AP Exam in the spring and if they earn a 3 or higher on the exam, can earn college credit. The cost of the AP Exam for this year was \$102.

Transcripted Credit (17) ~ Transcripted Credit is also known as dual enrollment courses. A student in high school signs up for a course that has an agreement with a post-secondary institution and if they meet the requirements of the course, the student receives high school and college credit...for free!
