
## Registration Timeline

- © Counselors will meet with students individually from March 19<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup> through English classes. Students can bring questions about classes to this meeting.


# HOW DO I REGISTER ONLINE?

The process is laid out step-by-step in the following slides.


1.Student signs in to their my.ncedcloud.org account. Then clicks on Student-Lea 900.




#### 2. Click on Class Registration




3. The student will see the screen below. Click on the pencil on the right hand side to see what classes the student can chose.



4. An example of the screen is below. Under the alerts column a teacher recommendation will be listed next to the recommended course. Select the course. Click okay at the bottom.



5. Once all courses and alternates have been selected, scroll to the bottom of main page and click submit. If you exit out before clicking submit, course requests will not be saved.



## Future Ready Core Graduation Requirements

Health/PE	1 Credit: Health/Physical Education
Academic Electives	6 Credits - 2 must be from either Arts, CTE or Second Language and 4 recommended concentration from either CTE, JROTC, Arts, or other academic subject area
Electives	6 elective credits from any area
Total Credits	28

## TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- When signing up for English, Math, Science and Social Studies classes, students must choose the academic level recommended by their current teacher as indicated in the online registration system. Under the alerts column next to the course it will say "Recommended by the name of your teacher."
- Students who want to take a higher then recommended level in a course (honors or AP) must have a parent sign a PRHS Course Level Change form. The counselor will enroll students in the higher level course once she receives the completed form. Forms are available in the Counseling Department.

#### ACADEMIC DIFFICULTY OF COURSES

- College Prep (CP) Course content, pace, and academic rigor follows standards specified by the NCSCOS with content enrichment where appropriate.
- Honors Course content, pace, and academic rigor place high expectations on the student and surpass standards specified by the NCSCOS. These courses demand greater independence and responsibility than CP Level courses. This level or higher is suggested for competitive college admission.
- Advanced Placement- Course content, pace, and academic rigor are college-level as adopted by the College Board and prepare students to take the AP examinations which may lead to college credit.
