

SOLO taxonomy, an example:

What do you know about houses?

Prestructural:

"You don't know anything"

What is a house?

Unistructural:

"You have an idea"

Houses are where humans live.

Multistructural:

"You have a lot of information but it is not linked"

Houses are buildings. They are made of walls, a roof, a door and windows. Humans live in houses. Houses are used to protect humans from bad weather conditions.

Relational:

"You have a lot of information and you can make links between the ideas"

Houses are buildings for humans to live in and find shelter. To provide shelter they have a roof which is waterproof and stops rain entering. Houses have windows so that light can get in but wind and rain cannot. Walls are there for shelter and to hold up the roof. Doors are used so that humans can enter but then stop wind and rain entering.

Extended abstract:
