- Plan to attend an Oregon public college or university

Oregon Transfer Module (OTM)

The Oregon Transfer Module is designed for students who plan to transfer to an Oregon community college or public university. Composed of 45 college credits, it is similar to many institutions' freshman and sophomore year

requirements.

COMPLETION OF THE OTM GUARANTEES THAT ANOTHER OREGON COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR PUBLIC UNIVERSITY WILL ACCEPT ALL 45 CREDITS TOWARDS GENERAL ED REQUIREMENTS.
