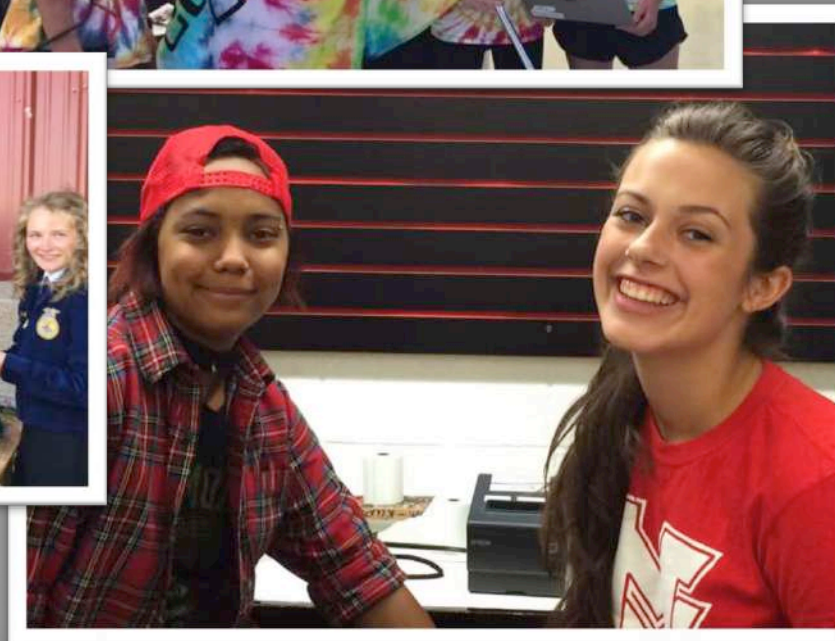

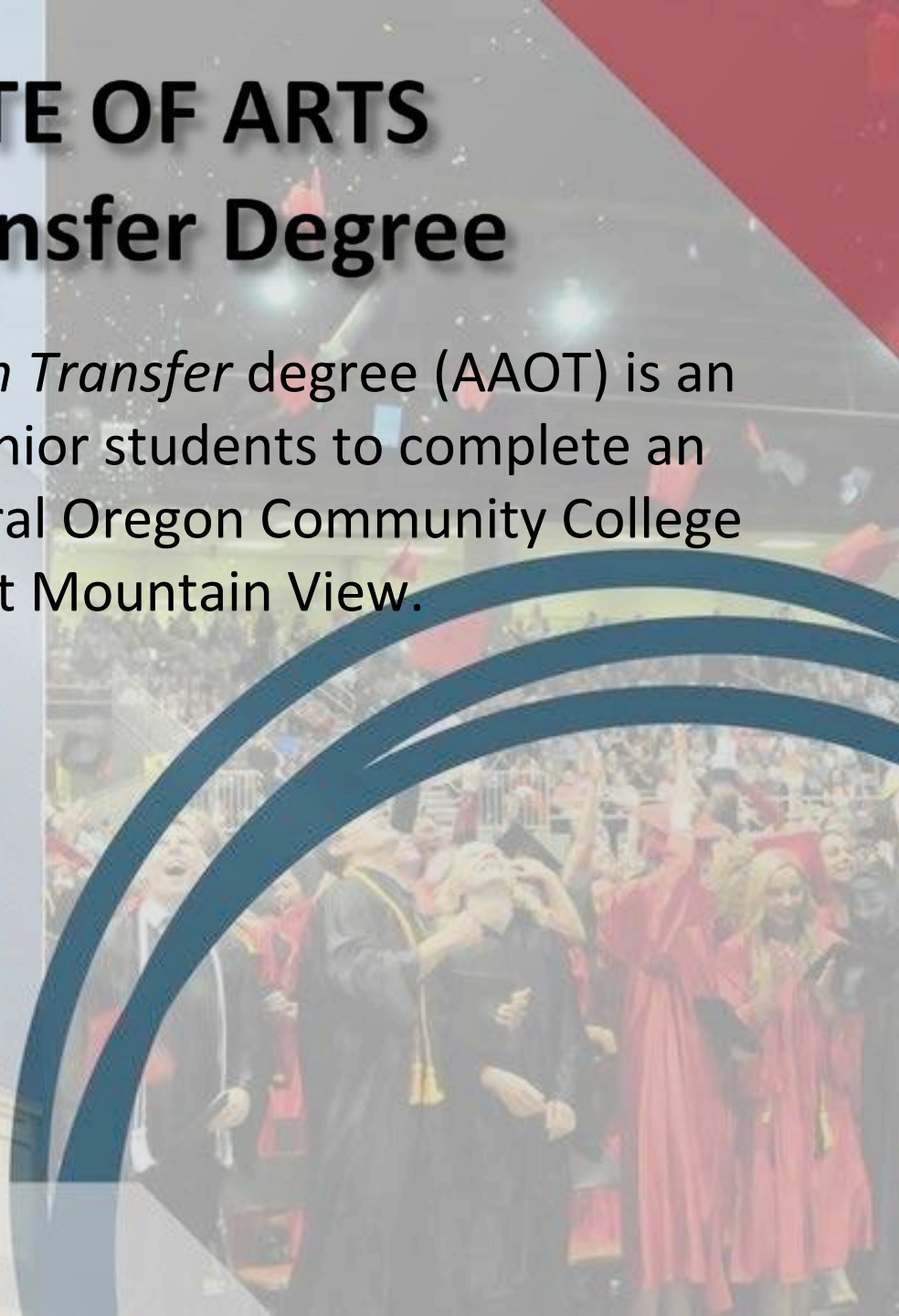


# ASSOCIATE OF ARTS

## Oregon Transfer Degree

The *Associates of Arts Oregon Transfer* degree (AAOT) is an opportunity for junior and senior students to complete an Associates degree from Central Oregon Community College while attending high school at Mountain View.

- ✓ EARN UP TO 66 COLLEGE CREDITS THROUGH COCC COLLEGE NOW COURSES AT MVHS
- ✓ EARN UP TO 24 COLLEGE CREDITS OR MORE TAKING CLASSES AT THE COCC BEND CAMPUS

### ***Am I Eligible?***

- ▣ **Complete 7.5 high school credits freshmen year**

- ▣ **Complete Algebra II by the end of sophomore year for the AAOT**

# AAOT and OTM Intent to Apply

- ▣ These grades will be part of my permanent high school records.
- ▣ I understand that the grades I earn through my courses at the college and dual credit classes will be put on my college transcript and used to calculate my college GPA.
- ▣ I understand that I must earn a 2.5 college GPA or better to continue participating in the program.
- ▣ Taking courses at COCC may interfere with my afterschool extracurricular activities.
- ▣ I must be enrolled in 5 classes to participate in OSAA sports or activities.
- ▣ I am responsible for my own transportation to COCC.
- ▣ During my senior year I may be at the college **full** time and not at MVHS.
- ▣ By enrolling in the AAOT or OTM these programs could impact my eligibility for the Oregon Promise Grant or other financial aid in the future.



# ASSOCIATE OF ARTS Oregon Transfer Degree

## *How do I apply?*

- ▣ Submit an *Intent to Apply* form at the end of your freshman year
- ▣ Begin the application process during winter of your sophomore year
  - Insight Resume
  - Authorization Form
  - Complete COCC application
  - Signed Release of Information
  - Commitment letter from your parent or guardian
- ▣ Plan to attend an Oregon public college or university

# Oregon Transfer Module (OTM)

The *Oregon Transfer Module* is designed for students who plan to transfer to an Oregon community college or public university. Composed of 45 college credits, it is similar to many institutions' freshman and sophomore year requirements.

- ✓ COMPLETION OF THE OTM GUARANTEES THAT ANOTHER OREGON COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR PUBLIC UNIVERSITY WILL ACCEPT ALL 45 CREDITS TOWARDS GENERAL ED REQUIREMENTS.
- ✓ SOME COURSES MAY MEET LOWER DIVISION MAJOR REQUIREMENTS
