- **Course Description:** Geometry will offer students a means of describing, analyzing and understanding the world around us. This course will allow students to discover patterns and formulate conjectures. Proof as well as real world problems will be emphasized. Students will use algebraic tools to verify properties of figures in the coordinate plane.
- Instructional Approach: Traditional teaching techniques will be used along with cooperative learning opportunities. Calculators will be permitted on certain assignments; please make sure you are using a scientific calculator. A scientific calculator will be loaned out to each students. The cost of a calculator will be \$15, if lost. Homework is the most vital part of this course. It is recommended that students maintain good attendance, stay organized, and do homework assignments daily. The homework schedule will be posted at the beginning of each week on the class website. A notebook with a section to keep handouts will be mandatory a three ring binder will work best. Class participation is the key to success in Geometry.
- Assessment and Evaluation: Everything we do is important and is therefore subject to a grade. Grades will be taken from the following sources: homework assignments, notebooks, journals, warm-ups, calculator and computer activities, quizzes, tests, projects, board work, participation and group work. Students can know their grades at all times by keeping track of their points and dividing it by the total points possible. There will be a mid-term and a final exam. The average of these two scores will be your final exam test score. The following is the school's grading scale:
