



## ***Accelerated Reader Construct*** ***English 9/10***

**Description:** *Select one Accelerated Reader book that you either thoroughly enjoyed or thoroughly detested. Create a visual display that is a suitable representation of your book—ideas are limitless. In your presentation, you will connect your visual with the story. Presentations should only last 2-4 minutes, so be prepared and concise.*

### ***Presentation Ideas:***

*When you present your story, you may choose to discuss some of the following---you don't need to elaborate on all of these.*

- ✓ *Setting*
- ✓ *Time period*
- ✓ *Main characters*
- ✓ *Plot—basically what happens. Don't retell every painstaking detail—sum it up. And please, PLEASE hint at the ending, but don't give it away.*
- ✓ *What was your impression of the book?*

### ***Visual Possibilities:***

- ✓ *Collage*
- ✓ *Build*
- ✓ *Draw*
- ✓ *Model*
- ✓ *Sew*
- ✓ *Bring in props...*

**Example:** *After reading The Diary of Anne Frank, I would bring in a replica of the attic that they hid in. Or I could bring in a personal diary—this is pretty obvious though.*
