

Description: Select one Accelerated Reader book that you either thoroughly enjoyed or thoroughly detested. Create a visual display that is a suitable representation of your book—ideas are limitless. In your presentation, you will connect your visual with the story. Presentations should only last 2-4 minutes, so be prepared, concise, well practiced, and poised.

Presentation Ideas:

When you present your story, you may choose to discuss some of the following---you don't need to elaborate on all of these.

- ✓ Setting
- ✓ Time period
- ✓ Main characters
- ✓ Plot—basically what happens. Don't retell every painstaking detail—sum it up. And please, PLEASE hint at the ending, but don't give it away.
- ✓ What was your impression of the book?
- ✓ What larger idea does the story illustrate?
- ✓ How did you feel about the author's style of writing? ...

Visual Possibilities:

- ✓ Collage
- ✓ Build
- ✓ Draw
- ✓ Model
- ✓ Sew
- ✓ Bring in props...

Example: After reading <u>The Awakening</u> by Kate Chopin, I would choose to bring in a metal birdcage.
