On **Tuesday, February 23rd at 8:00 am**, the ACT will be given at no cost to all 11th grade students in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools. This exam is a requirement by the state. Please keep in mind that CMS only pays for students in their 11th grade year to take this exam *and* those seniors who missed the exam last school year. Therefore, if you choose to take this exam at a later date, you will be responsible for payment.

In order to prepare for the ACT test day, please complete the following Google form https://bit.ly/3a8xG80 by February 9. If you have already completed the survey, you DO NOT have to complete it again.

Students who are taking the exam WILL NOT have Cato Middle College High School classes after the testing session ends at approximately 12:00, but WILL still have CPCC courses. Students will also need to personally email their professor and attach this CPCC Professor Excuse Letter https://bit.ly/39otP8A prior to test day, February 23rd (8a.m. -12:00p.m).

NOTE: If your child is not taking the exam they will have a High School asynchronous remote learning day.

The test consists of english, mathematics, reading and science sections. **NOTE:** There WILL NOT be a writing session.
