- 1) <u>Cause and Effect:</u> Cause is something happens and the effect is what happens because of the cause.

- 4) Rene-Robert de La Salle: French explorer, first European to set foot in Ohio.

- 6) <u>The Proclamation Line of 1763:</u> The imaginary line drawn down the Appalachian mountains which forbid the colonists from going west.
