<u>Drama:</u> Four to ten minutes of DVD, featuring monologue or other dramatic scene. Other actors may be in the scene, but the applicant's part should be primary. Be sure to include, in written form, an explanation of the set-up and any other information that may assist the committee. A script or written excerpt should be included.
