Assessments:

- Reading interventionists serving 50 kinder students

- Key personnel met and analyzed data in order to determine which students are below grade level and how to help them
- PK completed CLI wave 2 - showed areas that need to be targeted, reports sent home
- Students with IEPs are getting modified activities by sped teachers
- Kinder growth looking at assessments: 3rd 9 weeks math test data.
- 93.2% attendance rate, RAP not an option for absent students anymore causing lower attendance rate
- First grade tours are scheduled for 4-23
- Petting zoo was here for rodeo day, kinder is planning for community members to share, splash day is being planned.
- Bilingual teachers are always planning together and working hard for EL students

- Words of the week posted and reviewed daily on morning announcements, spanish is included
- Teachers are using so many different technology programs in their classrooms daily

Budget:

- teachers were met with and talked about resources needed
